SYSTEMS THINKING

Systems thinking suports innovation and organizational analysis. It differs from linear thinking which focuses on reactions to problems.

Linear Thinking

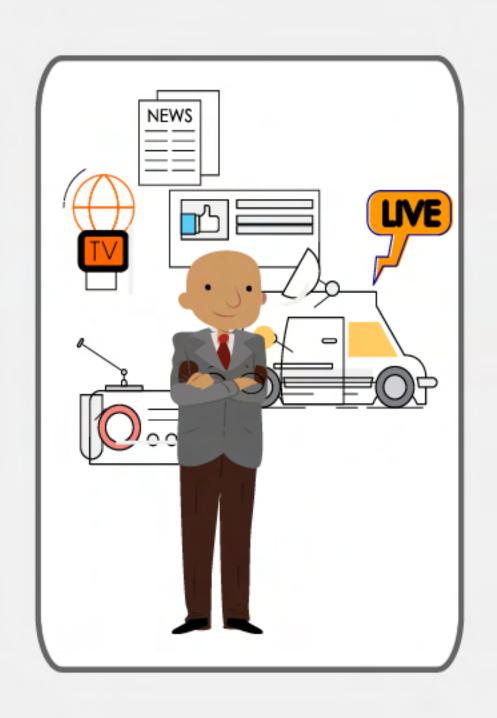
Based on reaction
Looks at individual parts
Focuses on cause-effect relationships
Views snapshots
Finds immediate solutions

Systems Thinking

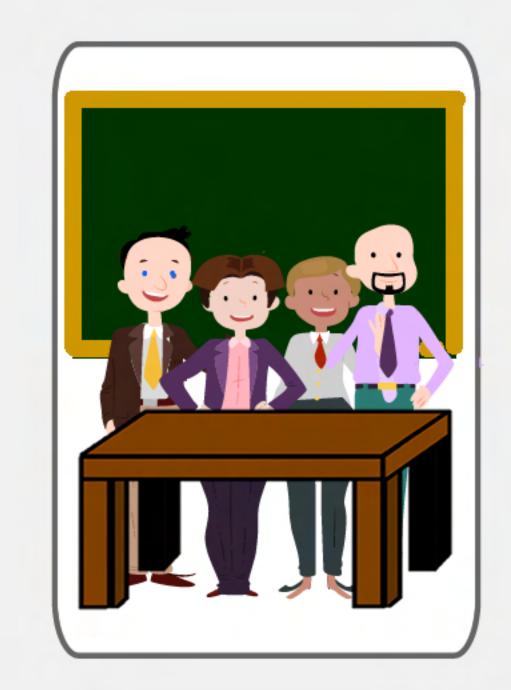
Based on analysis and undertanding
Sees the whole
Looks for root causes, linkages and corrections
Watches for change over time
Identifies strategies to address systemic causes

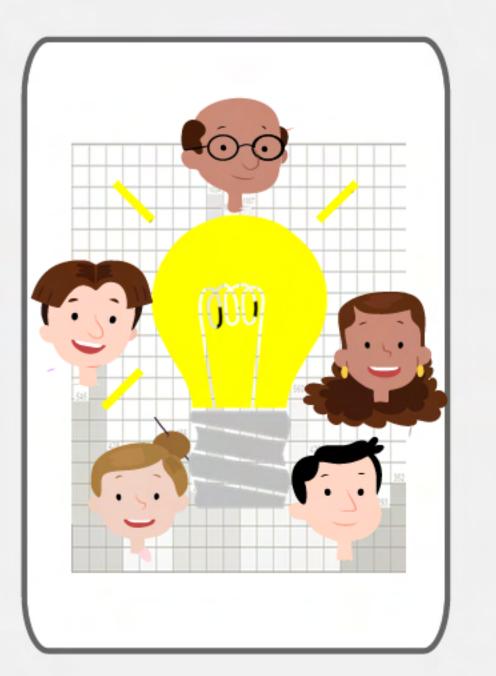
An example of shifting from LINEAR THINKING to SYSTEMS THINKING: Under-Enrollment

General Improvement via a Visible Solution

Systemic Improvement Based on Evaluation

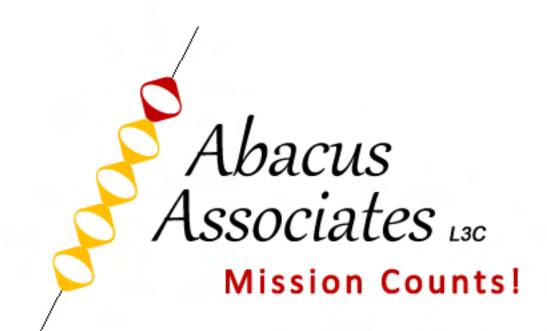
Assess which services are currently needed and in which communities. Shift recruitment efforts to be specific to those needs and to be delivered in targeted communities.

entire service area on
an ongoing basis.

Innovative Improvement Supported by an Organizational Analysis

Identify program changes
to support being fully
enrolled: Be proactive
with marketing, use
technology to track
workforce and housing
trends, monitor data to
identify future needs,
include recruitment duties
in all job descriptions, etc.
